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Extract from the Constitution April 2023

Part 2 Members of association

3 Membership generally

- 1) The following persons are eligible for membership of the Institute:
 - a) Employed full or part time for salary or wages as a Ranger; or
 - b) Employed full or part time for salary or wages as a law enforcement officer; or
 - c) Employed full or part time for salary or wages as an Animal Attendant; or
 - d) Employed full or part time for salary or wages as a member of a related government body, whose activities, in the view of the committee, are sufficiently related to the works of 1(a)-(c) above; or
- 2) An individual is taken to be a member of the association if:
 - a) the person is eligible for membership under one of the categories outlined in 3(1) above; and
 - b) the person applied to be a member under clause 5(1) below and the application has been approved, or
 - c) the person was one of the individuals on whose behalf an application for registration of the association was made under the Act, section 6(1)(a), or (d) the person was:
 - i. for an unincorporated body registered as the association - a member of the body immediately before the registration, or
 - ii. for a registrable corporation registered as the association - a member of the corporation immediately before the registration, or
 - iii. for an association that was amalgamated to form the relevant association - a member of the existing association immediately before the amalgamation.

(3) A person who is not an individual is not eligible to be a member of the association.

4 Associate Membership

- (1) Companies, not-for-profits, registered charities, and any such organisation whose activities, in the view of the committee, are sufficiently commensurate with the objects of the association may become associate members of the association.
- (2) An associate member has no voting rights.
- (3) Any associate member and or their representatives cannot be an elected member of the committee.
- (4) The benefits afforded to associate members are at the absolute and unfettered discretion of the committee.
- (5) The fees and subscriptions payable for associate membership are set out in clause 7.

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
